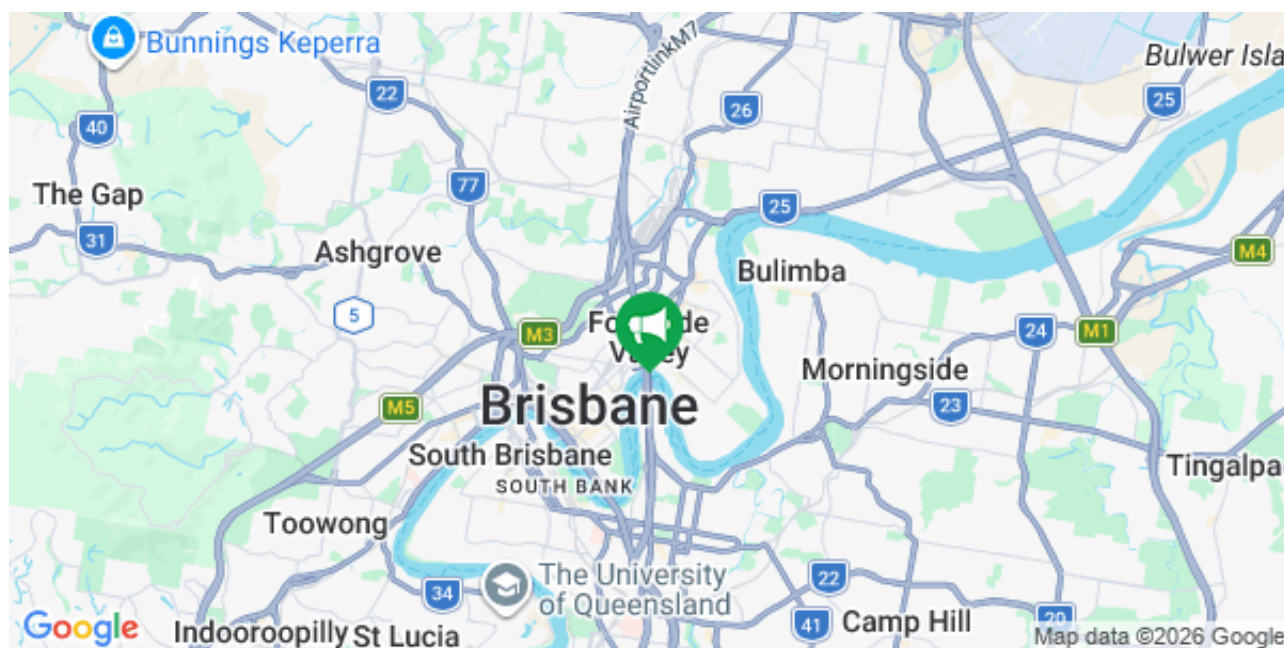

Australia Tactical: Cycle rally slated against proposed e-bike legislative bill in Brisbane from 17:30 (local time) on May 7; allot for disruptions

Current Situation:

- Activists associated with the Story Bridge Active Travel Alliance are slated to hold a cycle rally from Martin Street and ride over the Story Bridge in Brisbane from 17:30 (local time) on May 7.
- The scheduled demonstration is against a bill introduced by the Queensland State government on e-bikes. This bill will necessitate a licence to ride e-bikes, would impose a speed limit of 10 kph on them, and proposes a ban on the usage of e-bikes by those under 16.

Assessments & Forecast:

Participation at the slated protest will likely range in the low-to-mid dozens, based on the resonance of the issue. Per standard security protocol, security is likely to be bolstered in the vicinity of the aforementioned locations and along the rally route. These measures are likely to include the deployment of police personnel to manage travel disruptions. The protest is expected to transpire peacefully, considering the nature of the demonstration. Localized disruptions to pedestrian and vehicular travel are expected in the vicinity of the aforementioned locations and along the rally route due to the anticipated turnout and associated security measures on May 7.

Recommendations:

Those operating or residing in Brisbane on May 7 are advised to allot for disruptions in the vicinity of the aforementioned location and along the rally route due to the slated demonstration and associated security measures.
